

TOWN OF LEICESTER
TOWN BOARD WORK MEETING
TUESDAY, JANUARY 14, 2014

A work meeting of the Leicester Town Board was held on Tuesday January 14, 2014 at 7:00 p.m. at the Leicester Town Hall.

Clerk Mary Yasso swore in Joni Santucci for a four year term.

Present: Lisa Semmel, Town Supervisor; Karen Roffe, Dave Fanaro, Matt Durbin, Joni Santucci Council members; Russell Page, Highway Superintendent.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Supervisor Lisa Semmel.

The Board discussed the following topics:

- 1) Parking – Ideas were discussed for increased parking. The consensus was that any parking along the driveway onto Main Street would interfere with Town equipment. It was agreed that additional parking would be created behind the Town Hall in the spring.
- 2) Supervisor Semmel informed the Board that we are waiting for a response from the Village of Geneseo to proceed with a connection to the Town of York water system. There was a brief discussion on water quality and necessary waterline changes.
- 3) Brine plant- There is no news. Supervisor Semmel said that the Livingston County Board of Supervisors is searching for an environmental attorney.
- 4) Highway Superintendent Russell Page presented the 2014 Agreement to Spend Town Highway Funds for the County Highway Department. This annual form must be completed and returned to the County.
- 5) Highway Superintendent Russell Page suggested that the logs at the gravel pit could be surplus. Discussion followed on what to do with the logs and potential liability problems. Superintendent Page stated that in the future he would like make mulch available for the residents. Council member Dave Fanaro suggested that we hire someone to grind the logs, perhaps once a year. Superintendent Page will look into the costs of this and report back to the Board.
- 6) Highway Superintendent Page reported on the meeting with FEMA and said that there will be more meetings in the future.
- 7) Supervisor Lisa Semmel discussed the need to advertise for a cemetery caretaker and a mowing person. A job description will be created.
- 8) Supervisor Lisa Semmel stated that American Rock Salt will soon start the test borings to obtain core samples in order to test the quality of the salt.
- 9) Supervisor Lisa Semmel was presented an American flag by NYMR (New York Mutual Insurance) and it will be displayed at the Town Hall
- 10) Supervisor Lisa Semmel presented options and prices for a lockbox for the Town Hall.
- 11) Supervisor Lisa Semmel presented a list of goals for 2014. Council members will also present their goals.
- 12) Highway Superintendent Russell Page presented some ideas for some small improvements at the Town Highway Barn. It was agreed that the improvements were necessary.
- 13) Supervisor Lisa Semmel reviewed the accomplishments of 2013.

Adjournment - A motion was made by Karen Roffe and seconded by Dave Fanaro to adjourn. The meeting was adjourned at 10:00 p.m.
