Update on York Water

DEC has to do a list prior to hook up. No permits are needed at this time. Geneseo has permit and we are customers.

Department of Health – Mark Grovanz is reviewing the file to hook up.

As built plans for the meter pit at the town line

Also need confirmation on exact charges from York.

Leicester

Town is charging \$6.50 per 1000 gallons of water at this time.

Eric needs to get into pit to verify equipment. May be able to have new water in 2 months at best case.

Does not expect any additional cost in turning on water.

Tank Repair or Replacement

Opt. 1 repair holes to be completed by Nov. 1

Self tapping screws or weld patches.

Opt. 2 possible new tank. Up to 220,800 gallons. Budget \$350,000.

Need one day and a half of daily storage and fire protection.

What is the water level now with the condition of the tank?

Grand Status

Cuylerville water main replacement. Department of Health Disinfection Bi Products.

Level has been set to monitor Organics. May have to install an aeration system.

This unit can be installed in our tank.

Levels to be determined soon.

Cost may vary up to \$5,000.

Funding – Rural Development – EFC

Small Cities

MHI \$55,400 based on 2010 Census info (median household income)

Block grant has to benefit service area.  
Income survey needs 95% return

Rural Development seems to be the funding agency  
MHI does not look as though will help to achieve a grant  
Seems like a loan is the way to go.  
Possible to extend north on Rt. 36.  
Eric agrees to research costs to install new main to town like north.  
Eric concluded at 7:19 p.m.

Brine Plant  
Discussion in regards to it being closed for good.  
The County has hired a lawyer to litigate the cost of repair.

We all looked at the brick planter in front of town hall and agree to leave it as is for now.

The Supervisor attended the County Traffic Safety Board meeting to discuss the intersection of Rt. 36 and Perry Rd. due to the increased MVA's and the board agreed to review the information.

The Board decided to interview the 2 Leicester residents first. Mike Creamer and Bob Smith

The welcome to Leicester sign on 20A will be repaired by the Town Highway Men.  
The Board will consider new signs in the future.
