The Regular Meeting of the Leicester Town Board was held on Tuesday, March 18, 2014 at 7:00 p.m. at the Leicester Town Hall.

The meeting was called to order by the Supervisor and the Pledge to the Flag was led by Karen Roffe.

Minutes A motion was made by Dave Fanaro and seconded by Matt Durbin to approve the minutes from the February 18, 2014 meeting and the March 11, 2014 work meeting. Motion Carried, Ayes 5, Noes 0.

Financial Report The Financial Report was presented and noted that there were changes on page 5 & 7. Deposits were changed from DB to DA. A motion was made by Karen Roffe and seconded by Joni Santucci to accept the report. Motion Carried, Ayes 5, Noes 0.

Highway Superintendent

- A good share of the month was snow and ice removal.
- Maintenance, repair and fabrication on equipment.
- Brought in salt and sand a couple different times and mixed up.
- Installed a mail slot at the Town Hall.
- Supplied a 10 wheel truck to the Town of York for a water main break.
- Installed a driveway pipe for Chad Valentino on Caledonia Road.
- Installed an exhaust fan in the bathroom at the shop.
- Highway Superintendent attended Advocacy Day in Albany for our CHIPS money.
- Cleaned out the inlet of a cross over pipe for the Livingston County Highway Department on Gibsonville Road.
- A number of driveway pipes froze that we thawed out and one we had to temporarily repair (had a sink hole in it).
- Cold patching potholes.
- Thawed out Baumgardner’s water service on Jones Bridge Road.
- Assisted Al Mothershed with the Village. Staked out the water mains and services for the Village water main replacement.
- Assisted Al Mothershed with the Village. Located shut off/turned on the water service at Brian’s USA Diner for a valve replacement.

The Highway Superintendent updated the Board on the wood and logs at the gravel pit. The bid price for Terry's Tree Service to rent a machine is \$4,450/daily and \$22,500/weekly. The Highway Superintendent will talk with them and see if they will come and remove it instead.

Zoning Officer

- There have been 3 permits issued this year.
- The Zoning and Planning Board and him met with Mr. Orlando on March 10. He is supposed to have info in here and it is not here. He has till Monday, March 24th to get it to us. The Livingston County Health Department had 3 calls this week. Hopefully they have found something in their Zoning to help.
- He trained for disaster training.
- He went to FEMA training on March 5. People will be calling to complain about having to pay flood insurance.
- This week he is in training at RIT Inn and Conference Center for Code Officers.
