TOWN BOARD WORK MEETING

TUESDAY, DECEMBER 9, 2014

The work meeting of the Leicester Town Board was held on Tuesday, December 9, 2014 at 6:00 p.m. at the Leicester Town Hall.

Present: Lisa Semmel, Town Supervisor, Karen Roffe, Dave Fanaro, Matt Durbin, Joni Santucci Council Members; Russell Page, Highway Superintendent; Jim Campbell, Town Attorney.

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Supervisor Semmel.

Karen Roffe was appointed to complete meeting minutes.

Highway Superintendent Page reported on the following topics:

- 1) He informed the Board that there is a need for a snowplow wingman for mornings and days. The Board agreed to advertise for the wingman position.
- 2) In the past there was a Village-Town Highway Committee. Superintendent Page wondered if the Board was interested in doing that again. This will be discussed at the Town Board meeting.
- 3) Since the generator is no longer needed for the Caledonia Road water line he recommends using it at the Highway Barn.

A motion was made by Karen Roffe and seconded by Matt Durbin to enter into Executive Session. Motion carried Ayes 5, Noes 0.

A motion was made by Dave Fanaro and seconded by Matt Durbin to return to the regular meeting. Motion carried Ayes 5, Noes 0.

Supervisor Semmel stated that appointments to the County Traffic Safety Board will need to be made.

Joni Santucci reviewed the information she had obtained for purchasing a Cemetery Sign. There was also discussion on the condition of the signs at Boyd Parker Park. Supervisor Semmel will forward to the Board the information that she had received from Historian Tom Roffe. The Board will discuss the signs at the next Town Board meeting.

A motion was made by Joni Santucci and seconded by Matt Durbin to adjourn at 8:57 p.m. Motion carried Ayes 5, Noes 0.
