TOWN BOARD WORK MEETING

TUESDAY, MARCH 10, 2015

The Leicester Town Board met from 5:15 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. with Clark Patterson Lee engineers Mr. Eric Wies and Mr. Andrew Kosa to review options for sanitary sewer project, salt storage barn, and preliminary cost estimates for water mains.

The work meeting of the Leicester Town Board was held on Tuesday, March 10, 2015 at 7:00 p.m. at the Leicester Town Hall.

Present: Lisa Semmel, Town Supervisor, Karen Roffe, Dave Fanaro, Joni Santucci, Matt Durbin Council Members; Russell Page, Highway Superintendent.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Supervisor Semmel.

Karen Roffe was appointed to complete meeting minutes.

The Board interviewed Mr. Greg Torrey for the Assessor position which will be available June 2015.

The Board discussed the following topics:

- 1) Cemetery Caregiver Position – Since there was limited response to the advertisement the Board will re-advertise the position.
- 2) Boyd-Parker Park Signs – The Historian will provide the dimensions of the replacement signs so that the kiosk design can be selected and installed in the Park.

Highway Superintendent Russell Page reported that:

- 1) Brian Road – Superintendent Page is working with the Butlers for a possible settlement.
- 2) Backhoe – Superintendent Page provided the Board with cost estimates that he had obtained for the purchase of a new backhoe loader. After discussion the Board requested that the vendor be contacted to see if the quoted price was negotiable.
- 3) Superintendent Page reported that the Town currently has approximately 300-400 ton of salt remaining.

A motion was made by Joni Santucci and seconded by Matt Durbin to adjourn at 7:40 p.m. Motion carried Ayes 5, Noes 0.
