

TOWN OF LEICESTER
TOWN BOARD WORK MEETING
TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 9, 2015

The work meeting of the Leicester Town Board was held on Tuesday, February 9, 2015 at 6:00 PM at the Leicester Town Hall.

Present: Dave Fanaro, Town Supervisor; Joni Santucci and Jerry Hull, Council Members; Russell Page, Highway Superintendent; Ed Hauslauer, Highway Department; John Murphy and Robert Gepford, Blair Supply Corp.

Joni Santucci was appointed to complete the meeting minutes.

Karen Roffe, Council Member arrived at 6:20 PM.

John Murphy and Robert Gepford, Representatives from Blair Supply Corp. were at the meeting to discuss replacement of water meters in the Town of Leicester. They discussed the different types of Badger meters that were available to purchase. John Murphy will submit quote to review at next week's Board meeting.

Ed Hauslauer requested to attend a Water Certification Class in Wyoming County on March 16, 2016 for a cost of \$20. Ed will get paperwork to Mary Yasso, Town Clerk.

Rules and Regulations of the Water Department need updating. Ed Hauslauer and Russell Page will supply current paperwork and will revise with the help of Dave Fanaro, Town Supervisor.

Highway Superintendent Russell Page discussed the following topics:

“Road Map” of Intent for 2016

- Jones Bridge Road – Change the cross pipe just west of Upper Mt. Morris Road, then oil and stone from Route 36 to Perry Road.
- Jones Bridge Road from River Road to Barratt Road – Stone and oil 3' edges of road.
- Barratt Road – Stone and oil 3' edges of road.
- Caledonia Road – Apply shoulders and stone and oil from Canandaigua Street to Lower Peoria Road.

- Canal Street – Stone and oil.
- Kingston Road – Stone and oil.
- Lower Peoria Road – Dig a weep, wedge some black top, and apply shoulders and stone and oil.
- Upper Mt. Morris Road – Stone and oil from the Park Road to Upper Mt. Morris Road.....If not this year next.
- Covington Road – Stone and oil from Barber Road to Starr Road.
- Bush Road – Wedge black top.
- Canandaigua Street – Install storm drainage on portions of the street, then pave.
- Apply some gravel to all the dirt roads.
- Crack fill Jones Bridge Road from Route 36 to River Road.

The Board also discussed the following topics:

- Brine Plant property to be surveyed for immediate sale.
- Bid Opening for the Salt Storage Barn 2/11/16 at 11:00 AM.
- G&G Services to do income survey for projected water line extension
25% down not to exceed \$2,400.

A motion was made by Karen Roffe and seconded by Joni Santucci to adjourn at 9:00 PM.
