TOWN BOARD WORK MEETING

TUESDAY, JUNE 14, 2016

6:00 P.M.

The Town of Leicester June work meeting was held on Tuesday, June 14 2016 at 6:00 p.m. at the Leicester Town Hall.

Present Dave Fanaro, Supervisor; Karen Roffe, Matt Durbin, Jerry Hull and Joni Santucci, Councilpeople; Mary Yasso, Clerk and Russ Page, Highway Superintendent.

Others Jena Snyder from Baldwin Business.

The meeting was called to order and was opened to Jena to explain lines in the budget and answer questions. It was decided to transfer \$12,500 into Road IMP DB51104A.

Mary Yasso left the meeting and Karen Roffe was appointed to complete meeting minutes.

Jay Lynch informed the Board of the following concerns about the cemetery:

- 1) There are two trees that are in very dangerous condition and when they fall they will damage monuments. The Board requested that estimates be obtained for the removal of two trees and four stumps.
- 2) Two Large monuments are in danger of falling and are a public safety hazard. Mr. Lynch obtained an estimate to repair the monuments by removing them from their bases, replacing the footers, and resetting the monuments. This will be addressed at the Town Board meeting.
- 3) The Cemetery records and map are in very bad shape, are extremely difficult to use and need to be organized and protected from fire. The Board discussed ideas.
- 4) A metal detector is needed to locate the marker pins for the burial lots. The Board has agreed to purchase a metal detector at a cost not to exceed \$200.00.

Supervisor Fanaro discussed the following topics:

- 1) Income Survey – The Survey is finished and there is the potential to obtain a \$750,000.00

Grant to fund the project.

2) Boyd-Parker Park – He met with Heather Grant and the Town may be able to obtain Grant

Funds for the design and planning of Park improvements. The Board
will suggest ideas for the Park.

3) Brine Plant – The land survey is finished.

Zoning – Karen Roffe distributed the Draft Zoning Law to the Board for review. Copies of the Zoning Law
have been sent to the to the County Planning Department and the Town Attorney for review.
