

TOWN OF LEICESTER
TOWN BOARD WORK MEETING
TUESDAY, JULY 11, 2017

The work meeting of the Leicester Town Board was held on Tuesday, July 11, 2017 at 6:00 p.m. at the Leicester Town Hall.

Present: Dave Fanaro, Town Supervisor; Karen Roffe, Jerry Hull, Joni Santucci, Matt Durbin, Council Members; Russell Page Highway Superintendent.

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Supervisor Fanaro.

Karen Roffe was appointed to complete meeting minutes.

The Board discussed the following topics:

- 1) Cemetery Concerns – A family headstone had been knocked off its base and Supervisor Fanaro immediately reported the incident to the Sheriff's Department. The headstone has been reset. The white fence parallel to Rt 20A-39 will be painted and the grass trimmed by the Sheriff Department work crew. The other fence is beyond repair. The Cemetery roadway is used as an access to the field behind the Cemetery. This has the potential to cause maintenance problems for the roadway, lawn ruts, and wide equipment may cause other damage. Supervisor Fanaro will contact the land owner to work on a solution.
- 2) Salt Barn Reimbursement – Supervisor Fanaro informed the Board that the Check will be sent very soon.
- 3) 2018 Budget – Next month the Board will start working on the Budget and Supervisor Fanaro reminded the Board to start thinking about projects and or changes.
- 4) Court Grant – Supervisor Fanaro informed the Board that an option to use the remainder of the Grant money could be to replace the Town Hall heating system.
- 5) Post Office building – The building is in the process of being sold and an easement from the Town is requested for the deck that is the entrance to the east apartment. The owner has been requested to provide lot line information. The Town Attorney is handling this matter.

Supervisor Fanaro was invited to speak at the York-Leicester Towners July meeting. The next meeting will be at Starr Park and they inquired if it would be possible to get help for setting up tables. Town Board members will help.

The 2017 Cuylerville Fire Department Contract and the 2017 Cuylerville Ambulance Contract are ready to be signed. A motion was made by Jerry Hull and seconded by Matt Durbin to allow the Supervisor to sign the Contracts. Motion carried Ayes 4, Noes 0.

Highway Superintendent Page discussed the following topics:

- 1) Pickup Truck – The new truck is here and is in use and needs to be detailed with the Town of Leicester signage.
- 2) Brian Road – Brian Road is a seasonal limited use road and he would like to discontinue the seasonal use designation. Supervisor Fanaro will contact the Town Attorney about the legalities of the use change.

A motion was made by Matt Durbin and seconded by Joni Santucci to adjourn at 7:50 p.m.
Motion carried Ayes 5, Noes 0.
