WORK MEETING
PUBLIC HEARING ON 2018 BUDGET
TUESDAY, October 10, 2017
6:00 P.M.

The work meeting and the Public Hearing on the 2018 Budget were held on Tuesday, October 10, 2017 at 6:00 P.M. at the Leicester Town Hall.

PRESENT: Dave Fanaro, Supervisor; Karen Roffe, Matt Durbin, Jerry Hull, and Joni Santucci, Council people; Amy Neumann, Town Clerk.

The Meeting was called to order. The pledge to the Flag was led by Dave Fanaro. The Public Hearing for the review of the Preliminary Budget for 2018 was opened at 6:05 P.M. The Supervisor asked if there were any comments or questions regarding the budget. There were none. The hearing was declared open for ½ hour.

There was a discussion about the Valentino's Culvert Extension is almost done. The supervisor reports that it looks great.

Discussion about some things the Town Supervisor and Town Board would like to focus on after the Budget is complete. Culvert/Driveway applications, possibly online on our Web page for the future. Jerry Hull mentioned he would like to see a structured process for this to be successful for the Town. This will be in coordination with Russ Page, Highway Superintendent.

Revision of Water Rules and Regulations is another topic that was discussed, along with possible permit applications for new Tap/Meter and fees to be focused on in the near future.

Cemetery Rates also to be a topic in the near Future. Review of current rates and revision of Future rates. Snyder Brothers are raising their fees.

Supervisor, Dave Fanaro mentioned to the board that there will be a meeting held on October 19, 2017 by Dept. of Health concerning the water test results. Our surrounding Towns also have high test results. The Standard water number was lowered to 80. Our Town averages at 90.

Dave Fanaro has also been in contact with Eric Weis concerning our current water system and possible improvements for water quality.

Discussion took place concerning No Trespassing and No Hunting on Town property. Supervisor and Board would like to discuss this more at length in future.

Sheriff Crew will be working in the area on November 11, 2017 Leaf pickup in Cemetery and on November 12, 2017 Leaf pick up in Village.

Russ Page, Highway Supervisor called during meeting and was selling the Gravel Crusher via online, Teitsworth Auctions. Board Voted to sell Gravel Crusher at a total price of \$10,800.00.

A motion was made by Dave Fanaro, seconded by Karen Roffe to have Russ Page sell Gravel Crusher via online Teitsworth Auction for total of \$10,800.00.

Cemetery sign, no action yet as per Dave Fanaro.

Supervisor, Dave Fanaro asked if there were any questions concerning the 2018 Preliminary Budget. No Questions were asked. Concluding the question, Supervisor, Dave Fanaro closed the Public Hearing for the 2018 Preliminary Budget at 6:35 P. M.
