

TOWN OF LEICESTER
TOWN BOARD WORK MEETING
TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 14, 2017

The work meeting of the Leicester Town Board was held on Tuesday, November 14, 2017 at 6:00 p.m. at the Leicester Town Hall.

Present: Dave Fanaro, Town Supervisor; Karen Roffe, Matt Durbin, Gerald Hull, Joni Santucci, Council Members; Russell Page, Highway Superintendent, Amy Neumann, Town Clerk.

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Supervisor Fanaro.

Supervisor Fanaro asked Lorri Soto and Terry Soto if they would like to address the Board. They accepted. Mr. Terry Soto addressed the board in seeking Easement of Town property up to 5751 Upper Mt. Morris Rd. for a potential water connection. Mr. Soto has spoken to the Letchworth State Park Engineers and they thought it best for Mr. Soto to seek an easement with the Town of Leicester.

Supervisor Fanaro response was that there will have to be several steps taken before this is considered by the board and the board agreed.

- 1.) Review of the property lines
- 2.) Village needs to approve, and Mr. Soto states this is already in the minutes at the Village.
- 3.) Supervisor to speak with Town of Leicester attorney, James W. Campbell
- 4.) Engineer for Town of Leicester, Eric Weise to establish a route to install if we move forward.

Russ Page, Highway Superintendent thinks DEC will probably be involved as well.

Mr. Terry Soto provided Supervisor Fanaro of maps he had and contact information for Michael Petti and Charlie King.

Supervisor Fanaro will be in contact with the Soto's.

Supervisor Fanaro spoke on the Flooding on River Rd. The ditch needs to be cleaned out. This is a County Rd. We were requested to close the Rd. as per Russ Page our Highway Superintendent. Dave Fanaro will follow up with Mr Higgins at the County Highway Dept.

Supervisor Fanaro presented the Board with No Crew Percentages for Livingston County Agencies 2008 to 2016. The results are not great. We need to learn what the Cuylerville Ambulance plans are to make numbers better.
