The Work Meeting of the Leicester Town Board was held Tuesday, December 14, 2021, at 6:00 p.m. at the Leicester Town Hall.

Old Business:

Rt. 36 Water District: PRV has been installed. Quality issues, so a lot of flushing. If this continues, we may have to install chlorine injection point by the meter pit.

New Business:

Discussion New Road Water Survey: Eric Weise is getting this to us and a PDF with link for the website. No communication from Village regarding the last meeting.

Water Line Expansion Survey, they can scan with phone and or get a copy from me to fill out physically. Eric Weis Requested Board and Supervisor to review before it is Signed and Sent out along with fact sheet. Once signed I can Send out with Kim's help.

A Motion was made to approve the Supervisor to sign and Amy and Kim to Mail out and place on website by Councilmember Matthew Durbin and Seconded by Councilmember Joni Santucci.

Motion carried. Ayes 4, Noes 0.

Appointment of New Code Enforcement Officer, Sean Sullivan: Contractor by trade and most work in Monroe County and only applicant to the position. Shawn Grasby will be here another month to help acclimate Sean Sullivan to the position. Agreed amount of \$10,000.00 for the year. Focus on the enforcement of the issues we have and get the warnings and issue penalties with good follow through.

A Motion was made to appoint Sean Sullivan as the Town of Leicester New Code Enforcement Officer at rate of \$10,000.00 for the year by Councilmember, Joni Santucci and Seconded by Councilmember, Karen Roffe.

Kiwanis Letter Request for Next Year: Request is usually \$3,000.00 and with everything going up the new request is \$3,500.00.

A Motion was made to approve the request to increase to \$3,500.00 donation by Councilmember Joni Santucci and Seconded by Councilmember Matthew Durbin.

Next Year's Meeting Dates Info: Town Board Organizational Meeting is most important on January 4th at 8:00 A.M. Time has been changed to 7:00 A.M. for the Organizational Meeting January 4th, 2022.

Supervisors Subjects: Water Rate Review for Town Board. Tracks costs from 2013 to 2021. A 4-year average O & M \$20,210.55. Current Rate is \$6.50 per 1000 gallons and to make up a 90% shrinkage we would have to raise the water rate \$1.94544. Supervisor is going to get ahold of Town Attorney for the procedure to proceed.

Cemetery: Windstorm, Ash Tree fell up at Cemetery Jason Yasso found and cut up and Highway Crew Cleaned up. Maple Tree fell and Dave cleaned up 2 trees and it broke some monuments. Russ wants to reach out to Town of York to see if they would let him use the mini excavator with thumb on it to clean up. Supervisor will get some quotes to fix headstones as well as get the trees maintained before the wind takes more down and causes more damage to other monuments.

Request from Village Resident to do some community service up in cemetery. He needs 100 hours, and he texts supervisor when he gets there and when he leaves. Town Board was okay with the community service.

Drainage for the cemetery to be addressed. Supervisor asked Jason Yasso to be involved with the solution.

December 21, 2021, Joe Green from White Creek Solar will be here for presentation along with York Town Board and request agenda from Joe for Presentation for review for our Town Board and York Town Board to review ahead of time. Leicester to get 55 megawatts, York get 80ish megawatts. Bill Bacon working on community benefit agreement. 94C used to be Article 10.
