Rt. 36 Water Update: Supervisor Fanaro updated the Town Board about restoration continuing and Pressure Valves being installed.

Third, 2008 One Ton f450 87,000 miles on it next year or two. Shared Service possible.

Supervisors Subjects: Honorable Al Mothershed, Town Judge passed away August 31, 2021. Town Supervisor and Town Board does not want to act currently to appoint a New Judge.
